### APPENDIX 4

#### SEEPAD STRATEGY

The Council considered, within its meeting on the 25<sup>th</sup> of August 2005, SEEPAD's long term strategic proposals and it adopted them in the view of their approval by the General Assembly.

There is no doubt that, considering the aim and the objectives stipulated by the Charter, the SEEPAD strategy would suffer certain adjustments depending on the directions that are to be set up globally by IFAC, by the World Bank, by FEE and by the other international bodies and depending on the future attitude of the World Bank and of IFAC towards the regional bodies, generally, and towards SEEPAD, particularly.

## SEEPAD STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES

1. The homogenization of education procedures for expert accountants and auditors.
2. The regional certification and licensing of auditors and expert accountants.
3. The cooperation in the view of implementing the International Standards of Financial Reporting and of the International Standards of Audit and Assurance in South-eastern Europe.
4. The harmonization of members' regional conduct with the IFAC Code of Ethics.
5. Developing the accounting services market in the region.
6. SEEPAD's fulfilling of all the conditions for the IFAC membership.
7. Supporting the professional bodies in the SEEPAD member countries in the view of the IFAC membership.
8. Supporting the creation of public – private partnerships in order to accelerate the accounting and audit reforms, for the countries in the region.
9. The collaboration and the cooperation in the view of supporting the achievement of the measures stipulated within the Action plans prepared by the World Bank, in each SEEPAD member country.
